Resolution 08-R-886

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings adopted a Downtown Plan in 2002 which called for transportation enhancements along Chetco Avenue (U.S. Highway 101); and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings and the Oregon Department of Transportation cooperated in a Chetco Avenue Improvement project between the Chetco Bridge and Fifth Street in 2006-07, which included transportation enhancements funded by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has developed plans for continuing transportation enhancement improvements on Chetco Avenue north of Fifth Street with a goal of providing pedestrian connectivity to Harris Beach State Park and continuity in its downtown streetscape; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation has invited the City of Brookings to apply funding for this project;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, that City Manager is hereby designated as the Authorized Representative for the City of Brookings in its application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for funding of the Chetco Avenue Transportation Enhancement Project Phase II Project under the Transportation Enhancement Grant Program.
