

**RESOLUTION NO. 90-R-483**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING SUMMER WATER RATES  
AND IRRIGATION PROCEDURES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to provide a more economical program for potential summer irrigation of residential lawns and gardens; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is essential to maintain an adequate water supply during the growing months of July, August and September; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is empowered under Ordinance No. 66-0-190, Section 7, Subsection E, to limit water usage and establish hours of water irrigation.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Brookings that the following summer water rates be instituted for the months of July, August and September 1990 only:

\$ .60 per/100 cubic feet for the first 1,500 cubic feet of water;

\$ .30 per/100 cubic feet over 1,500 cubic feet of usage; plus the other user charges as outlined in resolution 88-R-441; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that irrigation of residential lawns and gardens will be limited to even numbered days of the week for even numbered addresses, and odd numbered days of the week for odd numbered addresses; and,

**BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager shall have the power to terminate this 1990 summer rate and irrigation program, after three days of notice, if in his opinion an adequate supply of water for domestic consumption and fire protection is not being maintained.

This resolution will go into effect July 1, 1990 and shall expire September 30, 1990.
