

**RESOLUTION NO. 90-R-486**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING RATES FOR SANITATION SERVICES TO BE CHARGED BY CURRY TRANSFER AND RECYCLING TO CUSTOMERS IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 86-0-402, Section 11 states that rates for service shall be those currently approved for the franchisee by the city council by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 86-0-402, Section 11 states that the rates shall be attached to Ordinance No. 86-0-402 as Exhibit "A";

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Brookings that the following rates shall be approved, effective May 10, 1990, and shall remain in effect until such time as any change in rates shall be approved by the City Council:

An additional \$0.80 for each gate, fence, hallway and/or stairs per trip and weight limit of fifty-five (55) pounds per can thirty (30) gallon can; thirty-seven (37) pounds per twenty (20) gallon can; twenty-eight (28) pounds per fifteen (15) gallon can.

**CART SERVICE**

Sixty (60) gallon carts	-	\$27.01 per month

**OTHER**

1. Customer requested special pickup - \$5.50 minimum
2. Initial one time set up charge - \$4.50
3. Monitored inactive status - \$4.50 each time
4. Residential rental property owners to be responsible for sanitation charges.
5. Governmental added fees are to be added to these rates.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Brookings, that the City and CTR will further review rates specified herein as follows:

- (1) Over the next three (3) months the City of Brookings and CTR shall review and negotiate in good faith on the transfer stations component (except for the separate component for capital construction of transfer station) of the rate schedule. If within that time the parties are able to agree on the amount of the transfer component, that fee shall be made part of the rate schedule effective upon adoption. However, should the parties be unable to agree on the amount of the transfer component by August 10, 1990, the matter shall be settled by binding arbitration. In the event the fee which the arbitrator establishes as the transfer component shall be effective retroactive to August 10, 1990.

- (2) Over the next six (6) months the City of Brookings and CTR shall review and negotiate in good faith on the collection component of the solid waste rate schedule. If within that time the parties are able to agree on the amount of the collection component, that fee shall be made part of the rate schedule effective upon adoption. However, should the parties be unable to agree on the amount of the collection component by November 10, 1990, the matter shall be settled by binding arbitration. In the event the fee which the arbitrator establishes as the collection component shall be effective retroactive to November 10, 1990.

In the event of arbitration, both sides shall have fifteen (15) days from August 10, 1990 or November 10, 1990, whichever is applicable, to mutually agree upon an arbitrator. If the parties are unable to so agree, City of Brookings shall notify the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of Curry County and request that he appoint a qualified arbitrator.
