

RESOLUTION NO. 91-R-497

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RECYCLING PROGRAM
FOR THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.**

WHEREAS, recycling is an essential component of integrated solid waste management plans; and

WHEREAS, the recycling plan adopted by the County of Curry calls upon public agencies to establish in-house recycling programs and to purchase products made of recyclable materials; and

WHEREAS, recycling succeeds best and products made with recycled materials are priced lowest when an adequate and consistent supply of recyclable materials are made available to processors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Brookings that all City departments will recycle all materials used for which the City's franchised recycling agency or authorized non-profit organization may provide collection service; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Brookings, when purchasing xerographic and computer paper whereupon a choice exists between products manufactured with solely virgin materials or those manufactured in whole or in part with recycled materials, shall purchase products made with recycled materials when such products cost less than the price plus 5% of the equivalent product made with virgin materials and when the quality of the products are substantially equal unless in the opinion of the City Manager there exists compelling reasons to do otherwise.
