

RESOLUTION NO. 91-R-501

A RESOLUTION STATING CITY POLICY ON REPRESENTATION BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS OR COMMITTEES.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Brookings is guided by the government ethics laws of the State of Oregon as prescribed in ORS Chapter 244; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Common Council are further advised by the Ethics Guide for Public Officials as published by the Oregon Government Ethics Commission; and


WHEREAS, those in authority in government have a special opportunity and obligation to be a positive role model for constituents, colleagues, and subordinate staff; and

WHEREAS, the fundamental principle of ethics which should guide the behavior of all persons who exercise public power is the notion of avoiding even the appearance of wrongdoing;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Brookings that members of the Council or of any Board, Commission or Committee appointed by the Council shall not represent any other person or entity before the body upon which the member serves; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the Common Council shall not represent any other person or entity before any Board, Commission or Committee of the City of Brookings.
