

RESOLUTION NO. 91-R-508

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS IN SUPPORT OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENHANCED EMERGENCY 9-1-1 SYSTEM THROUGHOUT THE STATE OF OREGON.

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 3564 has been introduced to establish an Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 system throughout the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Brookings City Council has received and reviewed a draft of House Bill No. 3564; and

WHEREAS, the Brookings City Council believes that the establishment of the Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 program is essential for the health, safety and welfare of all citizens of the State of Oregon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Brookings City Council strongly supports the establishment of the Enhanced Emergency 9-1-1 system throughout the State of Oregon proposed in House Bill No. 3564, and directs that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Oregon Legislature, to Senator Bill Bradbury and to Representative Walt Schroeder.
