

RESOLUTION NO. 92-R-525

A RESOLUTION APPROVING RATES FOR SANITATION SERVICES TO BE CHARGED BY CURRY TRANSFER AND RECYCLING TO CUSTOMERS IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 86-O-402, Section 11 states that rates for service shall be those currently approved for the franchisee by the city council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 86-O-402, Section 11 states that the rates shall be attached to Ordinance No. 86-O-402 as Exhibit "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brookings that the following rates shall be approved, effective January 1, 1992, and shall remain in effect until such time as any change in rates shall be approved by the City Council:

\$0.80 per trip plus \$0.80 for each additional twenty-five (25) feet from the truck access. Long driveways \$0.80 for each trip. An additional \$0.80 for each gate, fence, hallway and/or stairs per trip and weight limit of fifty-five (55) pounds per can thirty (30) gallon can; thirty-seven (37) pounds per twenty (20) gallon can; twenty-eight (28) pounds per fifteen (15) gallon can.

Accounts with containers more than ten (10) feet from truck access \$0.80 per trip plus an additional \$0.80 for each gate fence, hallway and/or stairs per trip and a weight limit of fifty-five (55) pounds per can.

CART SERVICE

Sixty (60) gallon carts	-	\$27.09 per month
Ninety (90) gallon carts	-	\$36.16 per month
One hundred five (105) gallon cart	-	\$36.18 per month

OTHER


1. Customer requested special pickup - \$5.50 minimum
2. Initial one time set up charge - \$4.50
3. Monitored inactive status - \$4.50 each time
4. Residential rental property owners to be responsible for sanitation charges.
5. Governmental added fees are to be added to these rates.
