

RESOLUTION NO. 92-R-528

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE 1992 RECOMMENDED PACIFIC FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL ALLOCATION.

WHEREAS, the Pacific Whiting resource has been fully utilized for two years by the at-sea processor; and

WHEREAS, preference to shoreside processors will serve the best interest of Coastal communities and fishermen alike; and

WHEREAS, the allocation provides for an equitable sharing of the resource between all segments of the industry, and safeguard a portion for the on-shore processing industry, as well as protect the current interest of fishermen which have been fishing for whiting since 1978; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Management Council's recommended allocation policy will provide for an orderly transition from foreign involvement to the most appropriate American utilization of the whiting resource.


