

RESOLUTION NO. 92-R-547

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE SOLICITATION FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A COMPUTER NETWORK SYSTEM AT CITY HALL.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS:

1. The City of Brookings hereby determines that it is in need of a computer network system for City Hall, which expenditure has been previously budgeted for the 1992-93 fiscal year.

2. Because of the possible variation in the types of systems which may be installed, the service available for such installation and the possible variations in price, the City has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Brookings to seek a response from interested vendors by way of Requests for Proposals.


3. The purchase of the computer network system for City Hall, if in excess of \$25,000, is hereby exempted from the requirements of competitive bidding set out in ORS Chapter 279 and the City's Resolution 92-R-539.
