

RESOLUTION NO. 93-R-555

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE PURCHASE OF A USED AIR COMPRESSOR.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS THAT:

1. The City of Brookings determines that it is in need for an air compressor for the Public Works and Treatment Plant Departments. This expenditure has been budgeted for the 1992-1993 fiscal year.

2. Because substantial savings can be realized, because there is a limited budget with which to buy the accessories, and because of the savings to be realized in purchasing a used but adequate piece of equipment, the City of Brookings has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Brookings to purchase a used Ingersoll-Rand air compressor from Contractors Quarry at a price of \$10,970.


3. The purchase of the air compressor for the City of Brookings is therefore exempted from the competitive bidding set out in ORS chapter 279 and the City's Resolution No. 92-R-539.
