

RESOLUTION NO. 94-R-573

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE PURCHASE OF A USED BACKHOE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS THAT:

WHEREAS, The City of Brookings determines that it is in need of a backhoe; and

WHEREAS, This expenditure has been budgeted for the 1993-1994 fiscal year in the Streets, Water, and Wastewater budgets; and

WHEREAS, the City can realize substantial savings through purchase of a used piece of equipment which is adequate for the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it can purchase a used CASE 580 Super backhoe from Central Equipment at a price of \$46,054; and

WHEREAS, the City has investigated purchase prices from other vendors of similar backhoes and no better price is available for purchase of a similar piece of equipment; and

WHEREAS, there will be a substantial cost savings to the City if an exemption is granted to the competitive bidding requirements set forth in ORS Chapter 279 and City of Brookings Ordinance No. 85-O-389; and

WHEREAS, It is unlikely that such exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or substantially diminish competition for public contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS, BE IT RESOLVED that the purchase of a used Case 580 Super backhoe from Central Equipment is exempted from the competitive bidding requirements set out in ORS chapter 279 and the City's Ordinance No. 85-O-389.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Brookings shall proceed with the purchase of a used Case 580 Super backhoe from Central Equipment at a price of \$46,054.
