

RESOLUTION NO. 94-R-574

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE OASIS HOME SHELTER PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookings recognizes that there is a nationwide problem of domestic violence of battered women and children; and

WHEREAS, Curry County is experiencing the same problem of domestic violence of battered women and children; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide safe haven, counseling and support services to victims of domestic violence; and


WHEREAS, Oasis Home Shelter program is a non-profit organization that can and will provide haven, counseling and support services to victims of domestic violence;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Brookings supports efforts of the Oasis Home Shelter program in establishing and operating a facility providing a safe shelter for domestic violence victims, along with counseling and support to get them through this crisis in their lives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that although the City of Brookings is unable to financially support the Oasis Home Shelter program, the Mayor and City Council do urge the citizens of not only the City of Brookings, but also those of Curry County to support the Oasis Home Shelter program.


