

RESOLUTION NO. 94-R-575

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE PURCHASE OF A POOL HEATER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS THAT:

WHEREAS, The City of Brookings determines that it is in need of a pool heater; and

WHEREAS, This expenditure has been budgeted for the 1994-1995 fiscal year in the General Fund Parks and Recreation budget; and

WHEREAS, the City can realize approximately \$950.00 savings through purchase of a heater directly from the manufacturer of said heater; and

WHEREAS, there will be a substantial cost savings to the City if an exemption is granted to the competitive bidding requirements set forth in ORS Chapter 279 and City of Brookings Ordinance No. 85-O-389; and

WHEREAS, It is unlikely that such exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or substantially diminish competition for public contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS, BE IT RESOLVED that the purchase of a pool heater from Smith & Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$3,781.00 is exempted from the competitive bidding requirements set out in ORS chapter 279 and the City's Ordinance No. 85-O-389.
