

RESOLUTION NO. 94-R-577

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CURRENT PERCENTAGE (35%) PAID BY THE OREGON LOTTERY COMMISSION TO ITS RETAILERS.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Lottery Commission pays its retailers 35% of the net profit from the lottery operated poker machines; and

WHEREAS, a proposal has been made to reduce the percentage to retailers to 10% of the net profit from the lottery operated poker machines; and

WHEREAS, the BPOE #1934 (Brookings Elks Lodge) is an Oregon Lottery retailer; and

WHEREAS, the profits from the lottery operated poker machines are used to support the many services sponsored by BPOE #1934, including youth activities, community activities, charity and relief, drug awareness, Christmas baskets for the needy, visual aid (eye examinations), veterans services and scholarships for local students;


