

RESOLUTION NO. 95-R-587

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE PURCHASE OF BASE RADIO EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings determines that it is in need of new radio frequency base equipment; and

WHEREAS, certain monies have been budgeted for the 1994-1995 fiscal year in the Police Department budget; and

WHEREAS, the City can realize substantial savings through purchase of this equipment which is adequate for the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it can purchase said radio frequency base equipment from Clackamas Communications of Port Orford, and

WHEREAS, the City has purchased its existing radio equipment from Clackamas Communications and it is necessary for the continued, uninterrupted operation of the 9-1-1 center to purchase and install compatible radio equipment; and

WHEREAS, there will be a substantial cost savings to the City if an exemption is granted to the competitive bidding requirements set forth in ORS Chapter 279 and City of Brookings Ordinance No. 85-O-389; and

WHEREAS, it is unlikely that such exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or substantially diminish competition for public contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED ON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS, BE IT RESOLVED that the purchase of the radio frequency base equipment from Clackamas Communications of Port Orford is exempted from the competitive bidding requirements set out in ORS chapter 279 and Brookings Ordinance No. 85-O-389.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Brookings shall proceed with the purchase of the radio frequency base equipment for a price of **\$8,492.22.**
