

RESOLUTION NO. 95-R-588

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF LOCAL AGENCY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT AGREEMENT NO. 13117 BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF OREGON, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS CITY OFFICIALS, AND THE STATE OF OREGON, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, HIGHWAY DIVISION, TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR A PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES PROJECT.

WHEREAS, by the authority granted in ORS 190.110, 366.770 and 366.775, the State of Oregon may enter into cooperative agreements with the counties and cities for the performance of work on certain types of improvement projects with the allocation of costs on terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the contracting parties; and


WHEREAS, under provisions of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA), Oregon is required to set aside federal funds for projects to address transportation enhancement activities; and

WHEREAS, under said provisions, the City of Brookings plans and proposes to install 430 feet of 5-foot sidewalk; remove discontinuities; and, install handrail on elevated portions of the existing sidewalk on the southwest side of Highway 101 through Brookings, hereinafter referred to as "project"; and

WHEREAS, the project shall be conducted as a part of the Enhancement Program under Title 23, United States Code, and the Oregon Action Plan, with the Enhancement Funds limited to \$31, 680 and City of Brookings to be responsible for the match for the federal funds and any portion of the project which is not covered by federal funding.


