

RESOLUTION NO. 95-R-597

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE PURCHASE OF A USED TANK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S WATER TENDER.


The Common Council of the City of Brookings finds as follows:

- 1. The City of Brookings needs a new tank for the Fire Department water tender. This expenditure has been budgeted for the 1995-1996 fiscal year.**
- 2. Because of the savings to be realized in purchasing a used tank, the Common Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City of Brookings to purchase a used stainless steel water tank.**
- 3. The City has determined that a used stainless steel water tank is a unique and specialized item not readily available on the open market.**
- 4. The City has contacted several vendors concerning available used tanks. One vendor, AC Trucks, Inc., has advised the City that it has a used stainless steel water tank for sale at a price of \$12,500.**
- 5. The City has determined that this is the lowest available purchase price for a used tank having the required specifications.**
- 6. It is unlikely that an exemption from competitive bidding in this instance will encourage favoritism in the awarding of contracts or that it will diminish competition.**
- 7. The awarding of a contract to AC Trucks, Inc., for \$12,500 will result in substantial cost savings to the City.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS THAT:

The purchase of a used water tank for the City of Brookings as identified herein is exempted from competitive bidding set out in ORS chapter 279 and the City's Resolution No. 92-R-539.
