

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-R-643**

**A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES TO CREATE AN ENHANCED 9-1-1 DISPATCH CENTER.**

**WHEREAS, Oregon State law mandates that 9-1-1 dispatch centers become Enhanced 9-1-1 dispatch centers by the Year 2000; and**

**WHEREAS, 9-1-1 telephone taxes pay for conversion of dispatch centers to the more sophisticated E9-1-1 system; and**

**WHEREAS, Motorola is one of the primary providers of such equipment nationwide; and**

**WHEREAS, Curry County Sheriff's office has selected Motorola as the provider of their E9-1-1 equipment; and**

**WHEREAS, The City of Brookings 9-1-1 dispatch center now primarily uses Motorola equipment and much of this equipment will continue to be used after this dispatch center is upgraded to "Enhanced" capabilities; and**

**WHEREAS, the price of this Centracom Gold Elite Console with associated furniture and equipment and installation, service, etc. is \$324,122.25 (under a state contract) which will be available through the City's 9-1-1 telephone tax fund; and**

**WHEREAS, the awarding of a contract to Motorola will result in substantial cost savings to the City and effective conversion of the dispatch center to E9-1-1 capabilities; and**

**WHEREAS, it is unlikely that an exemption from competitive bidding in this instance will encourage favoritism in the awarding of contracts or that it will diminish competition;**




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
**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS THAT:**

**The purchase of a Motorola Centracom Gold Elite Console, etc., in the amount of \$324,122.25 over a 5 year period is exempted from competitive bidding requirements under ORS chapter 279 and City of Brookings Resolution 98-R-539.**
