IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE ¹²~~H~~-O-693, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 17.136.080 OF
CHAPTER 17.136, CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT, OF THE BROOKINGS MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance Identified. This ordinance amends Section 17.136.080 of Chapter 17.136, Conditional Use Permits, of the Brookings Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amends Section 17.136.080: Section 17.136.080, is amended to read as follows:

17.136.080 Time limitation.

A conditional use permit shall become void after two years following approval, or after such greater time as may be specified as a condition of approval, unless within that time the required building construction, alteration or enlargement has been commenced and diligently pursued or, if no such construction, alteration or enlargement is required, unless the permitted activity is being regularly conducted on the premises. The City may extend the period of time allowed to establish the conditional use for an additional period of one year, for good cause if such extension request is submitted prior to expiration and subject to the requirements of this code. 
