WHEREAS, such funds have been requested to be expended for certain items, and


WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 329 provides that the Brookings City Council approve the acceptance and expenditure of such funds;



THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, NEW YORK, HAS THE HONOR TO ANNOUNCE THAT THE FOLLOWING ARE THE NAMES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE YEAR 1933:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors shall consist of nine members, to be elected by the voters of the county at the general election held in the month of November next preceding the expiration of the term of office of the members then in office. The members shall hold office for a term of three years, and shall be eligible for re-election.
