A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY RECORDER/TREASURER TO
CASH CITY VOUCHERS TO REPLENISH THE CITY PETTY CASH FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings currently has a petty cash fund
in the amount of \$125.00 for the purpose of financing expenditures
of the City in an amount of \$5.00 or less; and

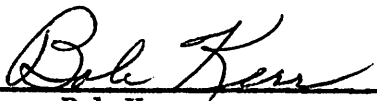
WHEREAS, the City Recorder/Treasurer oversees the petty cash

BROOKINGS, OREGON that the City Recorder/Treasurer is hereby authorized
to cash City vouchers approved for the sole purpose of replenishment
of the petty cash fund in an amount not to exceed \$125.00.

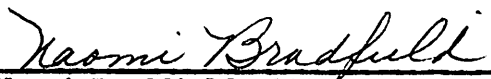
Resolution No. 252 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
