

RESOLUTION NO. 312

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, Section 17, Oregon Laws 1981, established an Emergency Communications Account to serve as a repository for monies collected from the three (3) percent telephone tax which became effective January 1, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Section 18 of the Act requires the Emergency Management Division of the State of Oregon to distribute quarterly to the Cities and Counties the balance of 9-1-1 funds in the Emergency Communications Account after certain specified payments have been made; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 533, Oregon Laws 1981, specifies that these funds are to be used only for the "Planning, installation, operation, and improvement of an emergency telephone system" by "local jurisdictions"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has on March 22, 1982 submitted a Letter of Intent to participate;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon hereby authorizes the establishment of that certain account to be known as the "9-1-1 Emergency Communications Account".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder be and hereby is authorized and directed to carry out all the provisions contained in this Resolution.
