

RESOLUTION NO. 329

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has held a hearing in accordance with ORS 221.230, and

WHEREAS, an extraordinary hardship to the community would be caused by unavailability of funds due to a tie vote on a levy election held on June 28, 1983, and

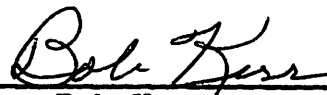
WHEREAS, lack of available funds would cause summer maintenance works to be delayed possibly through the annual rainy season, and

WHEREAS, ORS 221.230 provides for relief by the declaration of an emergency election to avoid extraordinary hardship to the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Brookings that a special election be held at the earliest convenience to alleviate any extraordinary hardships to the community in accordance with ORS 221.230,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Staff is hereby directed to proceed with the necessary steps for creation of said election.
