

RESOLUTION NO. 334

A RESOLUTION DEDICATING A CERTAIN BIKE PATH TO THE PUBLIC FOR RECREATION PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has received a grant through the Parks and Recreation Division of the Oregon Department of Transportation to construct a bicycle path in the right-of-way of Railroad Avenue from Wharf to Oak Street; and


WHEREAS, under said grant, the City is required to dedicate the bikepath to the public forever for recreational purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, is in agreement with the terms and conditions of the document prepared for said dedication, being attached as Exhibit "A", and hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute same on behalf of the City of Brookings this 10th day of August 1983.

EXHIBIT "A"

DEDICATION OF BICYCLE PATH
TO THE PUBLIC

KNOW ALL PEOPLE BY THESE PRESENTS, that the City of Brookings, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, does hereby grant and dedicate unto the public forever for recreational purposes a bicycle path, located in the City of Brookings, over and upon the following-described premises:

The north five (5) feet of Railroad Avenue from the easterly boundary of Wharf Street to the westerly boundary of Oak Street, Brookings Plat No. 1 recorded in Book 1, Page 5 of Plats filed in the official records of Curry County, Oregon.

RESERVING UNTO THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, the following:

1. the right to construct and maintain said bicycle path.
2. the right to relocate the bicycle path within said right-of-way of Railroad Avenue at a later date if deemed desirable or necessary by the City of Brookings.
