

RESOLUTION NO. 341

IN THE MATTER OF THE TRANSFER OF ALL
COUNTY ROADS WITHIN THE CITY OF
BROOKINGS TO THE CITY OF BROOKINGS

WHEREAS the City of Brookings has heretofore entered into an intergovernmental agreement with Curry County, Oregon, wherein is provided the proposed transfer of public roads under the jurisdiction of Curry County to the City of Brookings, and


WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 373.270(6) and (7) the City of Brookings does desire to pass appropriate municipal legislation requesting that Curry County so surrender such roads to the City of Brookings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The City of Brookings does request Curry County to surrender jurisdiction over all County-owned roads and road right-of-ways within the Brookings city limits including, but not limited to, those described in Exhibit A attached hereto and by such reference incorporated herein.


(2) So long as such surrender is completed in appropriate legislative fashion by Curry County within four (4) months of the date of this Resolution, the City of Brookings shall and does herein accept said surrender and grant by Curry County upon its passage of such legislation.
