

RESOLUTION NO. 376

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING UNANTICIPATED FUND BALANCES FROM THE 1984-85 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has executed Requisitions and Purchase Orders for specific expenditures related to Fern Street water line and pavement repairs; and

WHEREAS, these specific expenditures are necessary to maintain our commitments to the citizens of the City of Brookings; and

WHEREAS, these expenditures were approved for the 1984-85 fiscal year at the Special Common Council Meeting held June 26, 1985; and

WHEREAS, funds were available in 1984-85 budget year and because these materials were not received for services not performed until after the close of the 1984-85 fiscal year, these monies became a part of the 1985-86 fiscal year budget as part of the beginning fund balance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, that funds totalling \$11,941.00 be appropriated as follows:

STATE TAX STREET FUND


