

RESOLUTION NO. 378

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A COMMITTEE FOR CITIZEN INVOLVEMENT, PURSUANT TO THE GOALS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THE OREGON LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings is required to create a Committee for Citizen Involvement, whose responsibilities are:

1. To assist the City Council in developing a citizen involvement program,
2. To assist in implementing the citizen involvement program,
3. To evaluate the success of the citizen involvement program and suggest new approaches, and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has conducted a thorough search for citizen volunteers from all geographic areas of the City and with a variety of viewpoints;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, that Exhibit "A" attached hereto, shall constitute the Committee for Citizen Involvement, and program responsibilities.

EXHIBIT "A"

CITY OF BROOKINGS CITIZEN INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM

The City of Brookings recognizes its responsibilities under the Statewide Planning Goals and Guidelines as required by the Land Conservation and Development Commission to prepare, adopt, and implement a "Citizen Involvement Program". This program is intended to assure that all citizens have an opportunity to be involved in all phases of the planning process.

In order to fulfill this responsibility, the City has adopted the following Citizen Involvement Program:

1. The Planning Commission is designated as the lead agency for citizen involvement.
2. Committees will be set up to review each of the major components of the Brookings Comprehensive Plan, as identified by the lead agency. This will directly involve more citizens in the phases of the planning process than are currently involved.
3. The times of regular Planning Commission meetings and special meetings shall be widely publicized. Notification shall be by at least one newspaper of general circulation within the community and posting at public locations, such as the library, City Hall, and post office. Notification will be given the week of the meeting.

The City shall continue to maintain records of all meetings, studies, and technical data, and make these available on request to all citizens at the City Planning Department.

4. A copy of the Brookings Comprehensive Plan, the City Zoning Ordinance, and relevant studies and maps will be available at the library and the City Planning Department.
5. Recommendations resulting from the Citizen Involvement Program shall be retained and made available for public assessment. The rationale used to reach land-use policy decisions shall be available in the form of a written record.
6. The City, through the Planning Department, shall provide adequate staff and other resources to ensure effective operation of the Citizen Involvement Program.

A periodic evaluation of this program shall be made by the Planning Commission, and the program shall be modified, if necessary, to meet the changing needs of the community.
