

RESOLUTION NO. 379

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, ADDRESSING THE 1984-85 BUDGET YEAR AUDIT REPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings has received an Auditor's Statement as required by ORS 297.425; and

WHEREAS, said Auditor's Statement discloses no material weaknesses in the audited financial report, but outlines modifications which would increase efficiency of the system; and

WHEREAS, ORS 297.466 (3) requires the Mayor and City Council adopt a Resolution addressing methods of implementing modifications outlined in said Audit Statement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City's Budget Officer be, and hereby is, directed to take the following action:

BUDGET -

The City staff will no longer budget a \$1,200 expense for police dispatch services from the Fire Department, as recommended by the Auditor. Recommendations to the Budget Committee will include no such interdepartmental transfer.

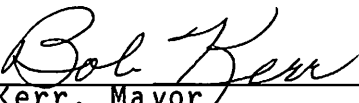
RESOLUTION NO. 358 -

The City staff will continue to pursue long-range planning for capital improvement programs and expenditures, and only in the case of extreme emergencies will such expenditures be made prior to the close of the fiscal year, thus precluding any necessity for similar activities in future budget years.

9-1-1 LOCAL JURISDICTION -

The City staff is hereby directed to proceed with the preparation of formal accounting records and compiling complete and separate minutes for all official actions taken as the lead agency for the 9-1-1 Local Jurisdiction.
