

RESOLUTION NO. 390

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AND THE CURRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, CURRY COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR THE CITY OF BROOKINGS FOR AN ENTERPRISE ZONE DESIGNATION FOR LANDS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY AND THE URBAN GROWTH BOUNDARY AREA.

WHEREAS, the 1984 Legislature adopted an Act authorizing the creation of Enterprise Zones for economically lagging areas, pursuant to ORS 284 and OAR Chapter 123, Division 13 - Economic Development Department; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, October 22, 1985, the Economic Development Commission selected a preliminary list of economically lagging areas, including Curry County; and

WHEREAS, the city of Brookings and Brookings Urban Growth Boundary area meets all of the preliminary requirements of Enterprise Zone designation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the city of Brookings and the Board of Commissioners of the county of Curry that:

1. The City Manager and Curry County administration be authorized to proceed with the submittal of the application form for the Enterprise Zone Designation; and

2. The Board of Commissioners of Curry County do support the application for the Enterprise Zone Designation for areas both within the city of Brookings incorporated limits and the area within the Urban Growth Boundary, as shown on the attached map exhibit.
