

RESOLUTION NO. 404

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings, Oregon, is the recipient of properties in Jacks Creek donated by South Coast Lumber Company; and

WHEREAS, a portion of one of those properties has been subject to certain claims and judgment liens which may cloud the title to such property; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to clear the title to such property in favor of the said City of Brookings; and

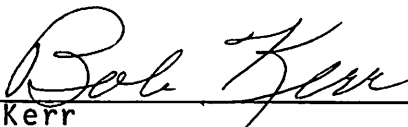
WHEREAS, it is necessary that the said title be cleared to allow the full use and enjoyment of said property for public park and other public purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, in special session this Thursday, April 23, 1987, that the City Attorney is hereby authorized to tender a reasonable offer to the owners of Tax Lot 101, Map No. 41-13-00, with Council approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event the said offer shall not be accepted by the owners within fifteen (15) days of the date hereof then the City Attorney is directed to file and vigorously pursue the condemnation of the subject property being the said Tax Lot 101, Map No. 41-13-00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the taking by condemnation for the purpose of a public park and for other public purposes is hereby determined to be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.
