

RESOLUTION NO. 414

WHEREAS, the Silver Complex Fire has consumed vast portions of the Siskiyou National Forest in the Chetco River watershed, and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings and its environs depend completely upon the Chetco River as the domestic water supply for most of the residents of Curry County, and

WHEREAS, failure to undertake an intelligent and responsible reforestation program will subject all downstream water supplies to degradation through accelerated erosion, sedimentation and mineralization;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Brookings, on its own behalf and on behalf of the urban residents of Brookings and southern Curry County that the Congress of the United States and the various departments of the Executive Branch of the federal government are encouraged to expeditiously develop and implement a management project which includes fire-killed timber salvage, rehabilitation of fish and wildlife habitat, watershed protection and immediate reforestation, and to this we pledge our support.

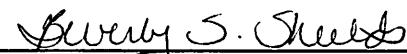
