

RESOLUTION NO. 424

A RESOLUTION TO REAPPROPRIATE WATER CONTINGENCY FUNDS TO THE 1987-88 WATER BUDGET, MATERIALS AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the expenses for engineering services budgeted under materials and services in the Water Distribution and Water Treatment Budget for fiscal year 1987-88 are significantly over budget due to unforeseen problems with the intrusion of salt water into the city water system; and

WHEREAS, the contingency in the water treatment budget is for the purpose of funding unforeseen expenses such as this and is available as follows:

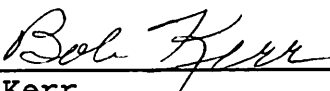
