

RESOLUTION NO. 425

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ESTABLISHING THE NAME OF AN EXISTING, UNNAMED, DEEDED CITY ACCESSWAY TO "WEAVER LANE".

WHEREAS, the subject 50-foot wide, unnamed, dedeed City accessway was accepted by the City resulting from minor partitions approved along said alignment and a City sewer line installed therein; and

WHEREAS, the Brookings Planning Commission did consider the naming of the subject dedeed City accessway at its meeting of April 5, 1988 at the request of an abutting property owner, Raymond C. and Helen L. Weaver; and

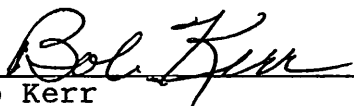
WHEREAS, in order to avoid confusion and conflict with addressing properties with Hassett Street numbers which do not front on Hassett Street for emergency and utility services response, it was determined by the Planning Commission that a separate street name and addressing be applied to the subject accessway alignment; and,

WHEREAS, the City building official, fire chief and postmaster have been notified of such proposal to name the subject accessway alignment and each has indicated there would be no conflict with existing street names; and

WHEREAS, the Weaver family has lived on this accessway for approximately the last 27 years, and they have petitioned the Planning Commission and City Council to assign the name of said alignment to **WEAVER LANE**;

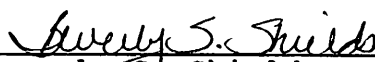
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brookings that the existing, unnamed, dedeed city accessway located North of Hassett Street, approximately 130 feet West of its intersection with Pioneer Road as depicted on the attached map Exhibit "A", be named **WEAVER LANE**.
