

RESOLUTION NO. 88-R-444

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO INITIATE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WITHIN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the city of Brookings as follows:

1. In order to lessen congestion and promote pedestrian and vehicular traffic safety along the Ransom Avenue alignment resulting from anticipated increases in traffic due to existing and expected development in the neighborhood, it is necessary and prudent to proceed with the full improvement of Ransom Avenue from its intersection with Sixth Street, westerly therefrom to the east right-of-way line of Barbra Lane.

2. That the City Engineers (H.G.E., Inc.), shall make a survey and plat of such proposed district and shall submit a written report to the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. 146, Section 4.

3. That upon completion of said report by the City Engineers, that the City Council of the City of Brookings shall set a public hearing on the matter of establishing an assessment district by publication and written notice to all affected property owners specifying the time and place where the Council will hear and consider written objections to the proposed assessment, pursuant to City of Brookings Ordinance No. 146, Section 6.

4. That the proposed boundaries of the local improvement (assessment) district are depicted on map Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
