
A RESOLUTION APPROVING A RATE SCHEDULE FOR CURRY TRANSFER AND RECYCLING, INC.

WHEREAS, on February 13, 1989, the City Council of the City of Brookings was requested to approve a rate schedule for Curry Transfer and Recycling, Inc.; and

Rates Effective March 1, 1989

EXHIBIT "A"

RATE SCHEDULE

COMMERCIAL RATE SCHEDULE

(1) Container Service - \$6.50 per loose yard

Roll Out Containers - 10% extra

Ramp Roll Out Containers - 20% extra

Monthly rates for 30-gallon can (weekly pick up) - \$7.00

Accounts with containers more than ten (10) feet from truck access \$.80 each trip plus an additional \$.80 through each gate, fence, hallway and stairs with a weight limit of fifty five (55) pounds.

RESIDENTIAL RATE SCHEDULE

SET OUT (CURB SIDE) SERVICE

\$7.00 per month for one thirty (30) - gallon can each week plus \$4.75 per month for each additional thirty (30) - gallon can per week.

Other Than Set Out Service

\$.80 per trip plus \$.80 for each additional twenty five (25) feet from the truck access. Long drive ways \$.80 for each trip. An additional \$.80 for each gate, fence, hallway and/or stairs per trip and weight limit of fifty five (55) pounds per can.

Residential and Commercial Charges

Other Charges

CART SERVICES:

Sixty (60) Gallon Carts - \$12.95
Ninety (90) Gallon Carts - \$14.95
One Hundred Five (105) Gallon Carts - \$15.95

- (1) Occasional extra in route pick up - \$2.00 Minimum
- (2) Customer requested special pick up - \$5.50 Minimum
- (3) Initial one time set up charge -\$4.50
\$4.50 each time charge to be put on monitored
inactive status.
- (4) Residential rental owners responsible for
sanitation charges.
- (5) Rates adjusted to Portland Consumer Price Index
Report each July 1 and submitted to the
Brookings City Council for approval.
- (6) Governmental added fees are to be added to these rates.
