

RESOLUTION NO. 89-R-453

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS SUPPORTING LEGISLATION PROPOSED BY U.S. SENATOR BOB PACKWOOD PERMANENTLY BANNING THE EXPORT OF LOGS FROM FEDERAL LANDS, PROHIBITING THE SALE OR EXPORT OF TIMBER FROM STATE LANDS UNLESS SUCH TIMBER WILL BE PROCESSED IN OREGON, AND FURTHER RESTRICTING FEDERAL "SUBSTITUTION".

WHEREAS, U.S. Senator Bob Packwood is introducing legislation which would permanently ban the export of logs from federal lands; and

WHEREAS, further legislation is being introduced to prohibit the sale or export of timber from state lands unless such timber will be processed in Oregon; and

WHEREAS, further legislation is being introduced to further restrict federal "substitution"; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Brookings unanimously agrees with Senator Packwood;

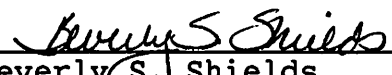
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brookings go on record in unanimous support of legislation proposed by U.S. Senator Bob Packwood permanently banning the export of logs from federal lands, prohibiting the sale or export of timber from state lands unless such timber will be processed in Oregon, and further restricting federal "substitution".
