

RESOLUTION NO. 89-R-454

A RESOLUTION TO THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, HIGHWAY DIVISION, REQUESTING A CORRIDOR STUDY, AN ACCESS STUDY AND DESIGNATION OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AND THE AREA FROM THE CHETCO RIVER TO THE CALIFORNIA BORDER AS A DEMONSTRATION PROJECT TO STUDY DEVELOPMENT OF AN OREGON COASTAL PARKWAY; AND CONTINUATION OF THE LONG RANGE PLAN TO CONSTRUCT A ONE-WAY COUPLET FOR HIGHWAY 101 TRAFFIC IN BROOKINGS.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division, developed a long range Highway Plan in 1985 to guide construction and maintenance decisions on the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division, has completed the first US-101 Improvement Strategy, the first element of the US-101 Planning Study; and

WHEREAS, the second element of the overall Planning Study is the Corridor Study;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Brookings and the Curry County Board of Commissioners request that the Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division, conduct a corridor study, an access study and designation of the City of Brookings and the area from the Chetco River to the California border as a demonstration project to study development of an Oregon coastal parkway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Brookings and the Curry County Board of Commissioners request that the Oregon Department of Transportation, Highway Division, continue the long range plan to construct a one-way couplet for Highway 101 traffic in Brookings.
