



RESOLUTION NO. 89-R-456

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY
CORRIDOR CONSENSUS PLAN.**

WHEREAS, the three western states as represented by Tri-State Highway 101 Council, have unique scenic resources of recognized national interest, and

WHEREAS, improved transportation links would provide full access to these resources from all regions of the U.S. and foreign nations, and

WHEREAS, these three states are in concert to provide this access via development of the Pacific Coast Highway Corridor in order to protect the environmental scenic beauty, enhance public safety, provide economic development, and

WHEREAS, a proposed \$9 million federal highway grant to provide a consensus plan would improve access by planning an effective transportation link referred to as the Pacific Coast Highway Corridor following the general alignment of Highway 101, and

WHEREAS, this planning grant may lead to funding a major highway improvement project of national significance, and

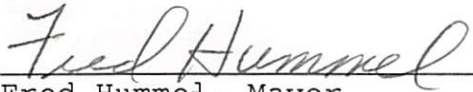
WHEREAS, representatives of coastal counties, cities, ports and special districts have pledged to join together to develop strategies that will provide a Pacific Coast Highway Corridor consensus plan that has in it the promise of federal highway funding, beginning in 1991, and

WHEREAS, this pledge of individual and combined energies will support state and federal congressional delegates as they carry this message; and

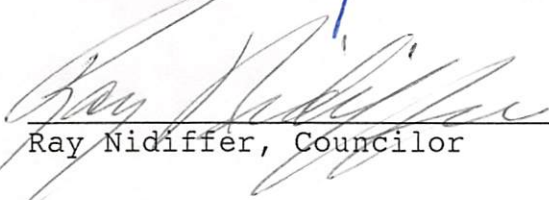

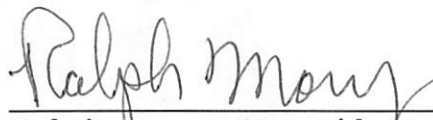

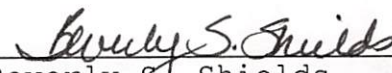
