

RESOLUTION NO. 89-R-469

A RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE CURRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO REQUIRE RELOCATION OF THE BROOKINGS ENERGY FACILITY CONSUMAT BURNERS.

WHEREAS, the Brookings Energy Facility consumat burners were located close to the City of Brookings so that the facility could provide electric power to the South Coast Lumber Mill on Carpenterville Road; and

WHEREAS, the Brookings Energy Facility has never produced any electric power and probably never will; and


WHEREAS, the Brookings Energy Facility burners are located within the Urban Growth Area of the City of Brookings which is experiencing an unusually large and sustained population growth rate; and

WHEREAS, the proximity of these burners to the expanding residential districts of the City of Brookings is a matter of concern to the citizens of this City and to their elected officials; and


WHEREAS, the Curry County Board of Commissioners is now considering options and alternatives for the disposal of the County's solid waste and may decide on this matter before the end of the year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brookings that the Curry County Board of Commissioners be hereby petitioned to require relocation of the Brookings Energy Facility consumat burners from the Brookings Urban Growth Area to a remote area at such time that the Board enters into a new or extended agreement with the operators of the Facility to provide solid waste disposal services in the County of Curry.
