

RESOLUTION NO. 241

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY COUNCIL'S INTENT TO HAVE THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION PREPARE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR A CITY-WIDE STREET AND STORM DRAINAGE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the best interest of the City of Brookings to have a City-Wide Master Street and Storm Drainage Program for the improvement of the City street system and storm drainage system, and

WHEREAS, a City-Wide Master Street and Storm Drainage Program is essential to aid in guiding orderly growth and development within the City of Brookings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council on March 11, 1980 in regular session did resolve that the City Planning Commission prepare a report and recommendation for the preparation and implementation of a City-Wide Master Street and Storm Drainage Program. Furthermore, the City Council specified that the Planning Commission should file its report and recommendations on or about May 9, 1980.
