

RESOLUTION NO. 243

A RESOLUTION TO THE OREGON COMMISSION ON PUBLIC BROADCASTING
TO EXTEND THE OEPBS SIGNAL VIA MICROWAVE TO THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

WHEREAS the City of Brookings is a part of the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS the City of Brookings is supportive of the Oregon Educational
and Public Broadcasting System with their State income tax dollars; and

WHEREAS the OEPBS television signal does not reach the citizens of
Brookings either over-the-air or via cable television; and

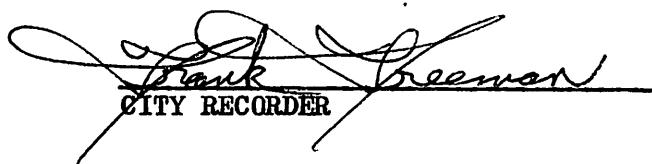
WHEREAS the State of Oregon is considering an extension of the OEPBS
signal via microwave to the Brookings area, providing the complete
schedule of national Public Television offerings, in-depth Oregon legis-
lative coverage during bi-annual sessions, statewide public affairs pro-
gramming, and in-class instructional material co-ordinated to Oregon
school curriculums;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS that we
formally request the State of Oregon, through the Oregon Commission on
Public Broadcasting to extend the OEPBS signal via microwave to the
Brookings area. We understand this project will cost approximately
\$200,000.00 of which 75% will come from the Federal Government, and
25% from the State General Fund. We believe this small State expenditure
is justified by our growing population, and the rights of all Oregonians
to be served by their publically owned broadcast system.
