

RESOLUTION NO. 258

A RESOLUTION SETTING AN ELECTION DATE TO SUBMIT A ONE-YEAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATION FOR THE 1980-81 FISCAL YEAR.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings did not receive voter approval of a tax levy outside the Constitutional limitation at the election held June 24, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to submit to the voters an amount outside the Constitutional limitation on the next available election date; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, an election will be held on Tuesday, September 16, 1980 in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon; the polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; and the following ballot measure shall be submitted to the qualified voters:

ONE-YEAR PROPERTY TAX
LEVY FOR OPERATING PURPOSES

"A" BALLOT

QUESTION: Shall the City of Brookings be authorized to levy \$ 161,794.00 outside Constitutional limitations for financing City operations during 1980-81?

PURPOSE: The reason for the levy is to provide necessary funds to conduct the general operation and services of the City as the existing tax base of \$125,533.00 and other available revenues are not sufficient to adequately support City services.


STATEMENT OF EXPLANATION: If this measure is approved, \$ 161,794.00 of the taxes levied will be financed partially by the State of Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder is hereby instructed to submit the ballot measure to the Curry County Clerk along with the "Notice of Measure Election" for publication in the Curry Coastal Pilot.
