

RESOLUTION NO. 236


A RESOLUTION PERMITTING CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF OREGON, TO NAME AND RE-NAME STREETS WITHIN SIX MILES OUTSIDE THE CITY OF BROOKINGS CORPORATE LIMITS.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

The Curry County, Oregon, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, shall, in the first instance, either itself through its commissioners or a body duly appointed by them, be able to name and re-name streets within and without the six mile limits surrounding the municipal corporate limits of the City of Brookings, which right under ORS 227.120 belongs to said City, upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:


- a. That such power herein granted to Curry County shall be exercised only by them in regard to the rural address system being enacted by said County throughout Curry County, Oregon; and
- b. That before such names or re-naming of existing streets and roadways shall be allowed, Curry County shall submit such names or re-naming thereof, and the locations appurtenant thereto, of the streets so effected thereby to the City Council of Brookings, Oregon, for their ultimate and final approval; and
- c. The authority given hereunder by the City to the County shall be for a period of one year from the date of signing hereof; however, upon due cause shown, a renewal and extension of this agreement may be delegated to the County by the City upon proper application to the City Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon.
