

RESOLUTION NO. 221

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

BE IT RESOLVED By the Council of the City of Brookings as follows:


That for the more efficient control of automobile parking in the City of Brookings, the following traffic control devices and markings shall be installed in the City of Brookings:

(a) That a sign be posted prohibiting parking on the east side of Oak Street for a distance of 80 feet as measured from its intersection with Chetco Avenue (adjacent to the Beaver State Motel).

(b) That signs be posted in all City parking lots limiting parking to two hours total time per vehicle from the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.


(c) That signs be posted on Chetco Avenue between Oak Street and Pacific Avenue limiting parking to a total time of one hour alongside the curb from the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
