

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide for the safety of the citizens of the City of Brookings and for more efficient and safe control of vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the City of Brookings by installing uniform traffic control devices,

THEREFORE, the City of Brookings does herein and hereby ordain:


a. A stop sign installation on Ross Road at its intersection with Elk Drive.

b. A stop sign installation on Ross Road at its intersection with Fifth Street Frontage Road.


c. A fifteen (15) MPH speed limit established on that portion of Fern Street between Pacific Avenue and a point five hundred feet (500 ') North of Elk Drive.

d. Installation of a mid-block crosswalk on Easy Street at the Old Seventh Day Adventist School.
