

RESOLUTION NO. 231

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS TO INITIATE A PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT WATER IMPROVEMENTS AND SEWER SERVICE; AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SPECIAL BENEFIT ASSESSMENT DISTRICT TO BE BENEFITED THEREBY; AND DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO MAKE A SURVEY AND PLAT OF SUCH PROJECT AND SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT; AND EXPRESSING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS TO ASSESS THE REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE SPECIAL BENEFIT ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR ALL OF THE COSTS OF SAID PROJECT; AND SPECIFYING THE METHODS OF NOTICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookings preliminarily deems it expedient to construct water improvements for the benefit of the special benefit assessment district described hereinafter, now, therefore,

(1) The City of Brookings, through its City Council, does hereby, pursuant to Section 4, Ordinance No. 146, enacted May 10, 1960, declare its intention to initiate a project to construct water and sewer improvements to benefit the real property described in Section 2 hereinafter, which real property shall be the special benefit assessment district.

(2) The special benefit assessment district is described as:

Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9, Iowa Tract Subdivision in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon.
ALSO, that parcel of real property situated in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon and designated by the Curry County Assessor as Tax Lot 2200, Account No. 41-13-08-BB.

(3) The City Engineer of the City of Brookings is hereby directed to, on or before December 31, 1979, make a survey, plat and report of such project in accordance with City Ordinance No. 146, Section 4. The City Engineer to make his report and file it with the City Recorder on or before January 8, 1980. Public Notice of the hearing on this project shall be published.

(4) That the petitioners, Lee and Fern Van Duzee have agreed to pay all reasonable expenses of creating this special benefit assessment district should it not be created.
