
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES  
IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of the City of Brookings, as follows:


That for the safety of the citizens of the City of Brookings and for the more efficient and safe control of automobile and pedestrian traffic in the City of Brookings, the following traffic control devices and markings shall be installed in the City of Brookings:

- a. A stop sign controlling southbound traffic on Center Street at the intersection of Center Street and Railroad Avenue.
- b. A "NO LEFT TURN" sign controlling southbound traffic of Fern Street between the Shell gasoline station and Brookings Paint and Floor Covering Store.
- c. A stop sign controlling traffic on Elk Drive at the intersection of Elk Drive and Fern Street.
- d. A "NO LEFT TURN" sign on an alley which has one-way traffic going southbound, which alley terminates at the intersection of Center Street and Chetco Avenue. Said sign shall be installed and remain until the State Dept. of Transportation improves the traffic signal at the above intersection such that the signal also control traffic driving on the above-described alley.
- e. A "NO LEFT TURN" sign controlling traffic exiting from an alley at the U. S. National Bank onto Chetco Avenue.
- f. Installation of a mid-block crosswalk on Pioneer Street between Pacific and Easy Streets.
