


RESOLUTION NO. 200


WHEREAS, Curry County has activated a court challenge to the constitutionality and the authority of the Oregon Land Conservation and Development Commission, and

We want to be sure the record shows that you will have joined us in specifically retaining attorney George Kirklin to obviate any later challenges on this aspect of the case.

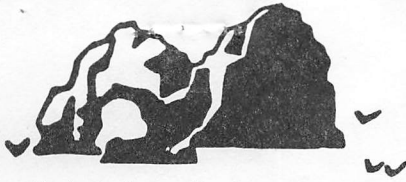
As soon as we've got all these in the case will be filed.
