

RESOLUTION NO. 201

IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING BROOKINGS MEMBERSHIP IN OREGON COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION.

NOW BEFORE THE City Council sitting regularly for the transaction of City business on the 26th day of July, 1977, is the matter of the adoption of a resolution establishing the City of Brookings membership in the Oregon Coastal Zone Management Association, (OCZMA);

AND IT APPEARING to the Council that ORS 190.010 permits a unit of local government to enter into written agreements with other local governments for the performance of any or all governmental functions;


AND IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Council that the Oregon Coastal Zone Management Association will perform those functions necessary for the development and implementation of Oregon's Coastal Zone Management Program pursuant to the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972;

AND IF FURTHER APPEARING to the Council that the membership, functions, finances and duration of the Association are as stated in the attached by-laws;


AND IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Council that the County will, by subsequent agreement, enter into an agreement with other members of the Oregon Coastal Zone Management Association for the payment of annual dues in an amount not to exceed ten thousand (\$10,000) dollars, which constitutes the aggregate total for all entities of government within Curry County;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City of Brookings will become a member in the Oregon Coastal Zone Management Association, and shall designate a representative and an alternate to the Association.
