

RESOLUTION NO. 164

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A special municipal election shall be held within the City of Brookings, Oregon, on the 6th day of July, 1972, at said special municipal election the following proposition or question shall be submitted to the legal voters of the said City for their approval or rejection:

For the fiscal year 1972-1973 shall the Council of the City of Brookings in Curry County, Oregon, be authorized to levy a tax \$28,262.00 in excess of the 6% limitation imposed by Article XI, Section 11 of the Oregon Constitution, for the purpose of hiring a full time fire chief, a draftsman, one additional street department employee and one additional police dispatcher and for such funds as may be required to provide facilities and supplies for such positions.

Section 2. The polling place for said election for legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, shall be the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City of Brookings; and said polls shall be open between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. on said election day.

Section 3. That the members of the Election Board and their respective offices are as follows:

Section 5. The City Recorder is hereby instructed to give notice of said election by posting copies thereof in the City Hall and in at least three public and conspicuous places within each precinct of the City of Brookings at least ten days prior to the date of said election and by publishing said notice in the Brookings-Harbor Pilot, a newspaper published and printed within the corporate limits of the City of Brookings, Oregon, once a week for two (2) weeks, the first publication of which shall not be less than ten (10) days prior to the date of said election. Said notice shall contain the proposal, ballot title and number in full, together with the time and place that said election shall be held.

Section 6. The Recorder is hereby directed to notify the election officials herein appointed of said election and to obtain and prepare all necessary ballots and supplies and furnish the same to said election officials.

The foregoing Resolution was duly passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 13th day of June, 1972.
